The meeting opened in the morning of the 24<sup>th</sup> with the first plenary. The former Chair of the Canadian Prime Minister's Advisory Committee on National Security, Mr. Norman Inkster, talked about terrorism and nuclear non-proliferation. Delegates put the stress on the cooperation between States, including the important role of the European Union, and the information sharing against international crimes.

Then the Delegates meted to work on the document that will be introduced to the attention of the Great 8: they are working on the same themes in the same place.

The day concluded with the second plenary, directed by Dr Jane Chamberlain Froese, the founder of "Save the Mother". Delegates confronted "Mother and Child Security". Mother Health is infact one of the 8 Millenium Goals, linked to reducing poverty and children mortality, fighting malaria and HIV, achieving gender equality and the primary education.
